

CONJUGATION OF THE VERB "TO HAVE"

PRESENT INFINITIVE	INFINITIVE	PRESENT PARTICIPLE	PAST	PAST PARTICIPLE
to have	have	having	had	had

PRESENT TENSE: Action takes place now or in the present time.

PERSON	SINGULAR	PLURAL
First	I have	We have
Second	You have	You have
Third	He/She/It has	They have

PAST TENSE: Actions or activities that began and ended in the past.

PERSON	SINGULAR	PLURAL
First	I had	We had
Second	You had	You had
Third	He/She/It had	They had

FUTURE TENSE: Actions that will take place in the future.

PERSON	SINGULAR	PLURAL
First	I will (shall) have	We will have
Second	You will have	You will have
Third	He/She/It will have	They will have

PRESENT PERFECT TENSE: Actions or activities that have taken place sometime before now.

PERSON	SINGULAR	PLURAL
First	I have had	We have had
Second	You have had	You have had
Third	He/She/It has had	They have had

PAST PERFECT TENSE: Actions or activities that were completed before another action or activity in the past.

PERSON	SINGULAR	PLURAL
First	I had had	We had had
Second	You had had	You had had
Third	He/She/It had had	They had had

FUTURE PERFECT TENSE: Actions that will take place in the future and end at a definite point in time.

PERSON	SINGULAR	PLURAL
First	I will (shall) have had	We will (shall) have had
Second	You will have had	You will have had
Third	He/She/It will have had	They will have had
