Supplemental Instruction

Supplementary Instruction is a free academic assistance program that uses peer-led study groups to help students in traditionally difficult courses – those with low completion rates (D's, F's, and W's).

They attend the lecture along with the students and prepare activity-based sessions that correspond with the material covered in class.
